"wise" (KJV—"only wise God our Savior"—Textus Receptus) is not in the oldest mss.; cf. esp. P ⁷² . Apparently inserted from recollection of Rom 16:27. 1 Tim 1:17 (Textus Receptus) makes the same insertion ("wise God"), again not supported by oldest mss.
